Position Description:

The Registered Nurse is responsible for the assessment, monitoring and administration of program participant nursing care and for communicating updates/changes to other parties (i.e. family, caregivers, and group home staff) as needed. The Registered Nurse is an important member of a larger team, and needs to be adaptable, exhibit leadership, good clinical judgement, and a steadfast commitment to maintaining a positive, supportive environment for our program participants. This position is also responsible for monitoring and maintaining program medical supplies and requires keeping clear and timely records. This position is 25 hours a week during the day, Monday through Friday.
